Dear Mohonk Preserve Member,

Listed below are some guidelines to help you get the most out of your visit to the Mohonk Preserve and Mohonk Mountain House lands. Please feel free to get in touch with the membership department if you have any questions or concerns about your membership at the Preserve. Thank you for your visit; we appreciate your support and hope you have a pleasant time.

When entering the Mountain House Gatehouse these rules apply:

- Preserve members can park in the Mohonk Mountain House Gatehouse lot when there is space available. The Mountain House requires a surcharge per Preserve member and a fee to use the shuttle. The Mountain House reserves the right to limit Preserve member parking at their discretion.
- The Mohonk Mountain House will no longer offer the reduced rate to Preserve members during the busy leaf-viewing season, the first weekend in October through the first weekend in November.
- Preserve members are required to have their current membership cards available and stop at the Gatehouse. Visitors without a membership card must pay Mountain House visitor day fees.
- The Mohonk Preserve does not charge admission for children 12 and under; however the Mountain House has a child rate when parking at the Gatehouse lot. A Dependent Mohonk Preserve membership card may be purchased from the Preserve for \$5. All Children within a member's party are subject to pay admission fees if they do not have a Dependent membership card when accessing Mountain House property.
- Groups are prohibited on Mountain House property.
- Preserve members and visitors are prohibited from going inside the Mountain House, its porches and the swimming area.
- Dogs are not permitted on the Mountain House property.
- Rock Climbing is only permitted through a designated guide service arranged through the Mountain House.
- Preserve members are allowed to bike on designated Mohonk Mountain House trails (Helmets are required and detailed bike maps are available at the Preserve Visitor Center and trailheads).
- All Preserve members must leave the Gatehouse lot by dusk. The Mountain House may not allow you to park and access trails after 2pm, to ensure you will be back to your vehicle by dusk.

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Mohonk Preserve members are subject to the following rules while on the Mohonk Preserve property:

- Members must wear their current membership cards visibly while visiting.
- Members must park in designated Preserve parking lots (Visitors Center, West Trapps, Coxing, Spring Farm and Pine Road).
- Trails and lots are open from sunrise to 1 hour after sunset.
- Visitors must stay on marked carriage roads or trails (see map).
- There is no overnight camping on the Preserve.
- No fires, glass or radios are permitted.
- Dogs must be on leash and under the control of the owner at all times.
- When biking or horseback riding, helmets are required.
- Bikers must stay on designated bike routes (detailed bike maps are available).
- Preserve members are allowed to cross onto neighboring publicly accessible properties only via authorized trails to Minnewaska State Park Preserve and the Mohonk Mountain House. Visitors must follow other property owner's rules and regulations.
